

ORDINANCE 2024-346

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF UNION BEACH, 1980,"

CHAPTER VII, TRAFFIC, SECTION 7-6.2, and Section 7A-8, Schedule VIII Stop Intersections, SCHEDULE VIII

Whereas, the Mayor and Council have determined that due to concerns for public safety that the intersection of Central Avenue and Pine Streets requires three (3) way stop signs with traffic on both streets being required to make a full stop.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF UNION BEACH that Chapter VII, Traffic, Section 7-6.2, Stop Intersections, and Section 7A-8, Schedule VIII Stop Intersections, is hereby amended to include the following: Central Avenue and Pine Street

The intersection of Central Avenue and Pine Street shall be designated a THREE WAY-STOP, with appropriate stop signs on each corner.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that Public Works shall erect stop signs on all three corners in accordance with all applicable NJDOT signs designs and location; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that if any provision, paragraph, section or subsection of this chapter be found unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this chapter shall remain in full force and effect and shall have continuing validity; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all other sections of the ordinance remain in full force and effect; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption in accordance with law.
