Due to this work, the roadway will be closed for a few weeks. Please follow local detours until the roadway is re-opened

Reconstruction of 8th Street between Florence Ave & Pine Street

Scholer Park will see an Installation of a paved walking track around the ball fields, with lighting

As we are all aware, Phase One of the Army Corp of Engineers Flood Protection Project has been completed! The new Beach area and crossovers look fantastic! We hope everyone enjoys it!
